

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) for EUM students

How to use your email, moodle and Stud.IP accounts?

University Email account:

Use your student number and password to sign in.

Moodle account:

This is a platform used by most EUF lecturers to send files and information throughout the semester.

Hochschule's StudIP:

to make an account at the Hochschule go to this link and register a "Zweithörerschaft Kooperationsstudiengang Energie- und Umweltmanagement Master": <https://cm.hs-flensburg.de>

1. Open Link
2. Click "Jetzt registrieren"
3. Click "OK"
4. Put in your information
5. After you've saved your information, you'll get an e-mail with a link and your Benutzerkennung
6. Click on Link and log in with Benutzerkennung and your chosen password
7. Decide about the getting notifications (2 things you can accept)
8. Click +Bewerbungsantrag hinzufügen
9. Choose Kooperationsstudiengang mit anderen Hochschulen
10. Choose EUM or EEM
11. Translate Berufsausbildung and Dienst and decide whether you have done/have either of them
12. Upload your Immatrikulationsbescheinigung
-> you can download this via [Studiport](#) (Benutzerkennung is something with your name, not your matriculation number)
13. Write down HSFL-K as the code
14. Scroll down check the box "Hiermit bestätige ich die Richtigkeit meiner Angaben"
15. Click on Antrag abgeben
16. Print out the documents and send it to the Hochschule or bring it to them at the H-Gebäude.

The code to register is: HSFL-K

How to choose your additional courses/Brückenkurse?

You might have to take additional courses to catch up specific requirements that other students have already acquired during their previous studies. The majority of new EUM students actually do have to take some additional credits.

Tips and general information on choosing your additional courses:

- Talk to more experienced master students to learn from them which courses are the best to choose; esp. ask students that have done their bachelor in Flensburg as they know many more course options

- Finalize your additional credits within the first 2 semesters as this eases your participation in other more advanced courses
- The grades of your additional credits do NOT count into your final master grade
- Additional courses would mostly be bachelor courses; however, if you struggle to find fitting bachelor courses you could also take master classes to fulfill your additional course requirements

Below, you'll find areas of study most of which you can choose several courses. Please note that if you don't speak German, your course options are smaller. We don't provide a comprehensive course list due to the quantity of the courses and frequent changes, but these links can assist you in finding suitable options.

Once you have decided which course you want to take, please verify with Prof. Oei if your choice fits via a short email.
