Linköping University provides a comprehensive teacher education and offers postgraduate training, as well as opportunities for research.

- Among the top 2% in the world in international university rankings.
- One of the top research institutions in Sweden within educational research.
- Research within education covers the entire range from children to adults.
- Pre-school teacher (Early Childhood) training in Norrköping since 1902.
- Primary-school teacher training in Linköping since 1860.
- Master´s programmes and courses in English.
- Each year we welcome around one thousand exchange students to the university and around 90 to the Faculty of Educational Sciences.

Programmes for Teacher Education taught in Swedish

Pre-school Teacher Program, 210 credits

Primary School Teacher Program

- Pre-school Class and Year 1-3, 240 credits
- Extended School, 180 credits

Secondary School Teacher Program

- Year 4-6, 240 credits
- Year 7-9, 270 credits

Upper secondary School, 300-330 credits

Study abroad – mobility window

1 semester = 20 weeks = 30 credits



Top marks for teacher education at LiU

Linköping University receives top marks in a recently published survey of teacher education in Sweden carried out by the Swedish Higher Education Authority (UKÄ). All of the teacher education programmes examined at LiU were given the grade “High Quality”.

Teaching practice /student teaching
