DFG fördert erste Forschungsgruppe an der EUF

DFG Forschungsgruppe „Antiziganismus und Ambivalenz in Europa (1850-1950)“, Sprecherin: Iulia Patrut

Wir freuen uns sehr über die Förderung der ersten EUF-Forschungsgruppe durch die Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG) und gratulieren der Sprecherin Prof. Dr. Iulia Patrut, ebenso wie dem Teilprojektleiter Prof. Dr. Matthias Bauer (EUF) und den anderen Mitgliedern der Forschungsgruppe. Unter dem Titel „Antiziganismus und Ambivalenz in Europa (1850-1950)“ wird die Gruppe bestehend aus Wissenschaftler*innen der Universitäten Heidelberg, Gießen, Marburg, Regensburg und Flensburg die Hintergründe, Verflechtungen und Dynamiken von Antiziganismus in Europa untersuchen. Verfolgt werden dabei zwei Hauptziele: Zum einen werden Ausgrenzung, Vorurteile und Stereotype, die zwischen 1850 und 1950 vorherrschten, untersucht. Zum anderen wird erforscht, wie Sinti*innen und Rom*innen in dieser Zeit eigene Handlungsmöglichkeiten entwickelten und nutzten. Am ICES angesiedelt sind drei Teilprojekte zu den Themen „Ambiguitäten des Audiovisuellen: Zigeuner-Figuren im Spielfilm (1895 - 1950)“ unter Leitung von Prof. Dr. Matthias Bauer (EUF) und Dr. Radmila Mladenova (Uni Heidelberg) und „Publizistik von Rom*innen in der Zwischenkriegszeit (1918–1939)“ unter Leitung von Prof. Dr. Iulia Patrut (EUF), ebenso wie das Verbundprojekt. ICES/ZeBUSS Project Grant Proposal Workshop

The DFG Project Grant (Sachbeihilfe) is Germany's most popular topic-open funding format for basic research. Are you considering to submit a Sachbeihilfe proposal or are already working on it, then our DFG Antragswerkstatt in Autumn Semester 2024/25 can support you along your way to submitting the proposal! This workshop, organized by ICES and ZeBUSS, is designed for post-doctoral researchers and professors, aiming to complete a DFG proposal over the course of the semester. Participants will meet every 3-4 weeks for 1 hour via Webex, forming interdisciplinary or subject-specific groups of 2-3 people. Each session will cover one or more different chapters in the proposal template, with a brief input from Simone Onur and Maria Schwab followed by a peer-to-peer discussion of the participants' proposal sections. Between sessions, participants will write the designated proposal section and share it a few days before the next meeting for peer review. The language of instruction and concrete dates will be determined in the first session. VolkswagenStiftung: Transformational Knowledge on Democracies under Change / Deadline for Task Forces: 29.10.2024

VolkswagenStiftung: – Transdisziplinäre Perspektiven auf Demokratien im Wandel

The Volkswagen Foundation's program aims to foster collaboration and networking between researchers and partners from (civil) society to develop new perspectives on democratic governance under change. This call supports interdisciplinary research projects exploring the transformation of democracy, with a focus on both academic and societal perspectives. The program offers two funding lines: **Task Forces:** Up to 180,000 euros for projects lasting up to one year, involving up to two researchers from different disciplines working with civil society partners to address specific challenges and publish actionable recommendations. **Cooperation Projects:** Up to 1.3 million euros for projects lasting up to five years, involving up to three researchers from various disciplines and civil society partners, aiming to translate research findings into concrete recommendations for politics, society, and business. **An online Q&A session** will be held on 6 August 2024 and 23 September 2024. Additionally, there are bilateral agreements with South Tyrol (Italy). Worldwide, the DFG partners with
