Volkswagen Stiftung fördert ein neues Forschungsprojekt am Institut für Frisistik

The neuro-cognitive and behavioral interplay between linguistic awareness, metacognitive efficiency, and decision-making strategies

We congratulate Prof. Dr. Nils Langer (EUF, Institut für Frisistik und Minderheitenforschung) and his team on securing 480,000 Euros from the Volkswagen Stiftung to fund their research project *“The neuro-cognitive and behavioral interplay between linguistic awareness, metacognitive efficiency, and decision-making strategies: evidence from bilingual and linguistic minority communities”*. The project will start in spring 2025, and is conducted in collaboration with Dr. Mikhail Ordin and Dr. Leona Polyanskaya from the Universidade de Coimbra. The project focuses on how increasing linguistic and social diversity across Europe affects decision-making. As more people migrate, bringing their languages, cultural values, and behaviors with them, these factors shape cognition and judgment. The research will explore the mechanisms that cause different decisions and behaviors in diverse settings, aiming to better understand

potential conflicts and develop strategies to mitigate them before they arise. The team will be supported by a postdoctoral researcher and a doctoral students, both fully funded by the project. If you would like to learn more about the project, get in touch with Nils Langer.

ICES/ZeBUSS Project Grant Proposal Workshop

The DFG Project Grant (Sachbeihilfe) is Germany's most popular topic-open funding format for basic research. Are you considering to submit a Sachbeihilfe proposal or are already working on it, then our DFG Antragswerkstatt in Autumn Semester 2024/25 can support you along your way to submitting the proposal! This workshop, organized by ICES and ZeBUSS, is designed for post-doctoral researchers and professors, aiming to complete a DFG proposal over the course of the semester. Participants will meet every 3-4 weeks for 1 hour via Webex, forming interdisciplinary or subject-specific groups of 2-3 people. Each session will cover one or more different chapters in the proposal template, with a brief input from Simone Onur and Maria Schwab followed by a peer-to-peer discussion of the participants' proposal sections. Between sessions, participants will write the designated proposal section and share it a few days before the next meeting for peer review. The language of instruction and concrete dates will be determined in the first session which will take place on Friday 18.10.2024 (10 am via webex). DFG: Joint Israeli-German Basic Research Projects/ Deadline: 30.10.2024

Erster Förderaufruf für eine ISF-DFG Lead Agency Procedure

The DFG (German Research Foundation) and the Israel Science Foundation (ISF) are pleased to announce the launch of a call for joint Israeli-German research projects which will follow a Lead Agency Procedure. According to this model, the evaluation of joint research proposals will be carried out alternately by one of the funding organisations which in turn will serve as the Lead Agency. In this first call, the DFG will act as the Lead Agency and will be responsible for the review and evaluation process. Israeli-German research teams are invited to submit joint research proposals within the scope of basic research in all fields of the sciences and the humanities. Applicants should demonstrate how bringing together researchers based in Israel and Germany will add value and advance their research. The Martin Buber Society of Fellows aims to foster interdisciplinary academic discourse at the highest level among exceptional postdoctoral scholars. Candidates who have completed their PhD at an Israeli or German university, or Israeli and German citizens with PhDs from any country, are eligible to apply. The PhD must be awarded between October 1, 2020, and July 1, 2025. Specialization in Humanities or Social Sciences is required, and there is no need for a connection to Jewish studies or Israel. Up to eight scholars will be selected. Fellows receive a monthly stipend of approximately 9,000 NIS (€2,197) and are expected to participate in academic activities in residence in Jerusalem.
