Join EUF's in-house academic editor and translator for a deep dive into the world of AI technologies as they intersect with the fields of academic editing and translation. Emphasizing the crucial role of human expertise when working with software like DeepL and ChatGPT, we'll explore how professionals use these tools to boost the efficiency, speed, and quality of their work. We'll identify standard and experimental practices, discuss ethical considerations, and examine the pros and cons of using these technologies in academic contexts.

In the second half of the workshop, participants will actively experiment with different AI-powered workflows, applying these to a variety of texts and communication scenarios. The session will conclude with a round-table discussion.

Participants should bring a laptop with internet access and submit a short sample of their own academic writing in English two weeks prior to the course, if possible.
